3. President's Report

6. Adoption of the Reports

- a. Sally motioned to accept the reports as presented. Renee seconded. Motion carried.

7. City of Calgary (Joylynn)

- a. In the fall every year, a survey (Neighbourhood Partnership Coordinators) is sent out to provide feedback regarding the work with Joylynn. This survey closes on the 14th of December at midnight. Feedback can either be anonymous or shared with Joylynn.
- b. New Q1 grant opportunity spreadsheets are on the City's website. Deadlines for grant applications are in January, February and March 2026.
- c. Collection changes for the green bin schedule is changing to every other week in November 2025.
- d. On January 10, 2026, at Inglewood Community Association, there is a "fundors and savers" get together. This provides communities with opportunities to either receive money or save money.
- e. December 02, 2025, the Copperfield Community Hall is booked from 7:00pm to 9:00pm to host ward 12 community associations for a meet and greet. The idea is to meet other board members and pass around ideas, questions and discuss topics that affect their communities.



8. Bylaw Sub-Committee Update/Re-Branding Brainstorming
